AN ASIDE...

1. There is progress at City Hall on this new park. Slow yes.
2. There is enough money for a decent ‘build out’.
3. A Working Group of City Hall staff, with Community reps will shortly line up an architect for park design.
4. The existing neighbourhood residents have hosted a park design consultation that will go to the competing park designers as part of our big picture ‘wish’ list.
5. The OMB required that all the open space around the buildings under construction is to be public access open space. There is a semblance of coordinated landscaping underway.
6. The park design is also intended to produce a plan a plan for various art installations to animate the public access open space.
7. A new theatre in the Carnegie Library is well on the way to being funded.
8. A18 is working on a plan to fund an exciting program of temporary art installations in the public access open space out of small contributions from condo fees.

THERE IS LOTS OF WORK TO DO YET. PLANS ARE TENTATIVE ON MANY FRONTS. BUT THERE IS MONEY ENOUGH TO BE OPTIMISTIC THAT A GREAT PUBLIC SPACE WILL EMERGE – RIGHT HERE. ACTIVE 18 IS A COMMUNITY GROUP THAT HAS WORKED ON THE PLANNING AND PARK ISSUED FOR THE PAST FEW YEARS STRIVING TO MAKE THE MOST OF THESE MASSIVE DEVELOPMENTS IN WEST QUEEN WEST.
